



UEMS EBDV EXAMINATIONS

New procedure including invigilating developed by the EBDV Examinations team:

- each candidate or group of candidates in **a suitable exam room** placed in an institution (hospital, university, library, training center) and
 - a local invigilator chief dermatologist, local examiner etc. both approved by our committee based on documents and pictures from candidates
 - invigilating by the EBDV examiners through ZOOM in mobile phones, candidates divided into virtual rooms.

The European candidates have been calling for the **live examination meeting** held in Europe again for the second time. As last year the ONSITE examination was very popular and successful, the live meeting for 2024 is planned to be organised in Frankfurt am Main, Germany, again. We plan to organise it in the Goethe University Hospital again.



RESULTS OF

European Board of Dermatovenereology Diploma (EBDVD) Examination in 2023

29 September 2023 – 4th REMOTE EXAMINATIONS

177 applicants

144 applicants who were accepted as eligible and paid the fee

33 of 177 asked to postpone their exams to the next year, one did not apear on 29 September

43 (of 59 originally) – including 4 repeaters, sat the exam in Frankfurt on 29 September 2023 (in 2022 we received only 27 applications from European candidates)

75 new candidates, + **29** repeaters sat for the examination in their home countries in the approved exam rooms.

42 of the candidates were EU citizens, **102** non-EU citizens

17 EU citizens failed (40%), 46 non-EU citizens failed (45%)

The results to all candidates and the electronical certificates for the successful candidates were distributed after evaluation and checking the results.

The first after-covid onsite examinations proved that for EU candidates is really easier and more comfortable to arrive to Frankfurt than to assure a suitable exam room in their hospitals or clinics.



The main task is preparation and organisation of annual Examinations of dermato-venereology,

including

- Preparation and regular updating and polishing of the questions
- Application and registration process, logistics, invigilating candidates both online and on-site, evaluation and checking results of electronical Examinations, distribution of the exam results and certificates, verification of certificates,
- The website information of the Examination, the rules and instruction for candidates,
- Promotion of the Examinations in Europe.

PROMOTION OF THE EBDVD EXAMINATIONS

- One of the main tasks connected with the EBDVD Examinations is there promotion in Europe.
- The state authorities have different attitude to our examinations
- Most of the formal non-democratic countries do not support passing this examination as the specialists who pass such an exam intend to work abroad and these countries are losing their experts in this way.
- Nevertheless, last years we cooperate with the member societies of the EBDV and they publish our advertisment on their webs or in journals.

The UEMS European Board of Dermatovenereology Diploma (EBDVD) Examination





UEMS EBDVD Examination is a test of excellence in Dermatology and Venereology. It is designed to assess the knowledge and clinical skills requisite to the delivery of a high standard of dermatovenereological care both in hospitals and in independent clinical practices.

DATE OF THE NEXT EBDVD EXAMINATION: 4th October 2024

HYBRID EXAMINATION: ONSITE (in Frankfurt am Main, Germany) and REMOTE ONLINE

EXAMINATION APPLICATION WILL START on 1st February, 2024

DEADLINES Deadline for APPLICATION: 1 st of April 2024

Deadline for PAYMENT: 31 st of May 2024

EBDVD EXAMINATION FEE

 550 EUR for candidates from the European Union Member State or the signatory country of the European Economic Area Agreement and the Switzerland, 750 EUR for candidates from other countries

ONSITE EXAMINATION - for those candidates who want to take the examination in Frankfurt am Main, Germany, where the examination room and local invigilator will be provided by the UEMS-EBDV. The exact venue will be announced when registration closes.

REMOTE ONLINE EXAMINATION - for those candidates who are able to ensure a secure room for their examination (classroom, meeting room, training room) in the hospital they work, university, headquarters of a national professional association and a reliable authorised person who would invigilate the examination (see "Requirements for the examination room, equipment and invigilator" in the chapter "INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES", see on our website).

STRUCTURE OF EXAMINATION

The examination is composed of 200 multiple choice questions (MCQs) with clinical slide collection included. The language available is English. The examination is divided into five sessions, each session has 40 questions.

Mr Rouffet highlighted the need to turn the CESMA member's expertise into policy documents pertaining to European Examinations in order to increase the consistency and quality of European Examination and pave the way to increased recognition by National authorities.

Dr Goldik stated that CESMA would start drafting policy documents based on the existing presentation and would seek CESMA members' input.

The European Accreditation Council for CME (EACCME®)

Under the impulse of a growing shift from voluntary to mandatory CME-CPD in Europe, the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS) set up the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME®) in October 1999.

The UEMS-EACCME® began its activities in January 2000 with the mutual recognition of accreditation of EU-wide and international CME-CPD activities for live educational events through the awarding of European CME credits (ECMECs) to individual medical specialists, allowing the recognition and exchange of CME credits between all European countries.

In April 2009 the UEMS-EACCME® launched the accreditation of e-learning materials. By e-learning is meant the delivery of CME-CPD by methods including: recorded audio, recorded visual, recorded on Compact Disc (CD), recorded on Digital Versatile Disc (DVD), available on Personal Digital Assistant


Our candidates call for such courses and we suppose they will be useful both for EU and non-EU candidates.
